General Rules of Spending:

- The Illinois AMVETS Service Foundation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under the laws of Illinois. Its purpose as set forth in the corporate charter is for "Service and Rehabilitation" for Veterans. These rules apply to all grants distributed from the Illinois AMVETS Service Foundation.
- Grants must be spent for the purpose of Service or Rehabilitation of Veterans.
- Grants are first come, first serve.
- Grant requests must be turned in at least 2 weeks prior to the grant committee meeting, which are held at the three SEC meetings. Those turned in late will be not be considered. Recommendations will be made by the Grant Committee, and then voted on by the Service Foundation body. (SEC dates are February 18-20, 2022, June 24-26, 2022 and September 16-18, 2022.)
- Requests must be made between August 1st and May 15th of each year.
- Funds cannot be used to purchase an item and give it away, such as purchasing tables, chairs, beds, etc., and giving them to a Veteran Home. You may not donate any of the funds received from the Service Foundation.
- The Receipt of Distribution must be returned to State Headquarters within 90 days after receiving grant funds.
- The following items must be returned to the State Headquarters within 60 days of the event occurring:
 1. Written report stating how the funds were used
 2. Original receipts
- It is suggested that your report and original receipts be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested. Your report should be in letter format, dated and signed.
- Those not adhering to these guidelines will be ineligible for subsequent year's grant request. The expenditures of grants that do not adhere to these guidelines will not be considered for requests next fiscal year.
- Your grant funds cannot be held over from year to year. Any unused portion must be returned to the Illinois AMVETS Service Foundation with your grant expenditure letter and original receipts in order to be eligible for any future request.
